PROJECT BACKGROUND: EpiC, or “Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control,” is a global project dedicated to HIV that is funded by the United States government and people. In 2022, TLF Sexuality, Health and Rights Educators Collective (TLF SHARE), a duly registered non-stock, non-profit organization was awarded a grant to leapfrog past the country’s obstacles that restrain the health care system, HIV program, and overall environment from being sufficiently sensitive to the needs of transgender women. The grant shall implement activities to support attainment and maintenance of HIV epidemic control among key populations, focused transgender women residing or working in Quezon City and City of San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan, by delivering pilot local trans health programs with HIV prevention, care, and treatment services.

JOB DESCRIPTION: The Trans Community Specialist shall work the project plan with the staff and management, development partners, and other interested parties to ensure that the project is responsive and sensitive to the trans community and health and rights concerns, which include but not limited to the following: (1) Representing the organization and/or providing close-in support to other representatives in gatherings, meetings and outreach; (2) Providing non-formal and informal learning facilitation; (3) Developing or providing inputs in concepts and operational details for project activities; (4) Proposing actions and guidelines, policy and programming recommendations; (5) Submitting reports and other documentation in relation to the foregoing; and (6) Performing such other functions as may be directed by management. Job level and compensation equivalent to Senior Technical Officer in health.

- At least two (2) years of work experience concerning sexuality, health and rights; rights-based and identity-affirming health development work an advantage
- Formal educational accomplishment as evidence of competence and expertise; above intermediate level in technical consulting and writing, policy and program development, and personal and organizational capability development are an advantage
- Additional compatible learning & development received and provided; focus expertise on sexuality & gender, HIV or other health and development subject matter preferred
- Trans women in possession of the desired qualifications strongly encouraged
